ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POLICY

The sale or service of alcoholic beverages on the campus of Sam Houston State University is not permitted except in agricultural courses as a part of the academic curriculum, "special use" buildings or designated facilities, all of which must be approved in advance by the President or designee. The University permits the use of alcoholic beverages at tailgate parties or picnic activities at designated NCAA intercollegiate athletic events only on the day of the event, during stated time parameters, and in the general proximity of the event, including outdoor locations or parking areas.

Departments, individuals, or sponsoring organizations of events (where alcoholic liquor, etc.) A room reservation on campus.

Alcohol for special events must be purchased from a current Texas State license holder, such as the University catering service, Area 12, or a vendor at Sam Houston State University. Alcohol is not permitted at University sponsored events. Insurance coverage in a sufficient amount must be provided. Academic courses may only be permitted as required by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission.

Alcohol may not be purchased with University funds (unless specifically budgeted for) or from restrictions on funds, the most common being the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission.

The possession and consumption of alcohol is controlled by Sam Houston State University's published policies. The legal age for the purchase of beverages in the State of Texas is 21. Possession of alcohol technology, including tasting without consumption, is prohibited. Change by action of the State Legislature or law. Violators of state law or University policy will be charged.
